1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files or similar technologies stored on or accessed from a device when a person visits a website. They can help a website function, remember choices, measure use, prevent abuse or support embedded services. Similar technologies may include local storage, pixels, tags and device identifiers.

2. Who is responsible?

3. Categories we may use

Category	Purpose	Consent position
Strictly necessary	Security, network management, form operation, load balancing, rendering of cookies and other functionality	Usually does not require consent, but functionality for
Preferences / functional	Remembering optional choices such as language, display or non-essential features	Consent may be required unless the technology is
Analytics / performance	Understanding visits, pages viewed, errors, traffic sources and general website usage	Usually requires consent before storage or access
Advertising / social media	Measuring campaigns, personalising advertising, retargeting, or enabling social media features	Requires consent before use where PECR applies.

4. Cookie consent

Where consent is required, optional cookies and similar technologies should remain disabled until the visitor takes a clear positive action, such as selecting "Accept" or choosing categories. Rejecting optional cookies should be as easy as accepting them. Consent must not be inferred from silence, continued browsing or a pre-ticked box.

6. Third-party services

8. Do Not Track and browser signals

Browser privacy signals are not implemented consistently across all websites and services. Where a recognised legal or technical standard applies to our website, we will take reasonable steps to honour it. The most reliable control is the cookie-settings tool provided on the website together with browser controls.

9. Personal information

Where a cookie or similar identifier relates to an identifiable person, our Privacy Policy also applies. It explains lawful bases, sharing, retention, security, rights and complaint options.

10. Updates

We may update this Cookie Policy when the website, consent tool, providers or legal requirements change. The website should be scanned periodically and after adding analytics, advertising, chat, maps, video, social-media, booking or payment functionality.
